Abolish Chronic Truancy

Referral Criteria

- Students 6-17 years old
- 6 unexcused absences
- 3 supportive interventions attempted by school



ROE will reach out to school staff for updated attendance every 30 days.

School staff will receive updates with ROE staff interventions.

ROE 1 Interventions Step 1

- Official Truancy letter 1 mailed with immediate needs survey
- Parent contacted via phone or text
- Start IOEP form

ROE 1 Interventions Step 2

If attendance does not improve

- Official Truancy letter 2 mailed with county resources
- School/home visits for parents that have been unable to contact
- Continue working on IOEP form

ROE 1 Interventions Step 3

If attendance does not improve

- Official Truancy letter 3 mailed with truancy ordiance
- School/home visit
- Goals set on IOEP

ROE 1 Interventions Step 4

If attendance does not improve

- Schedule truancy hearing date with school
- Attempt to call or text parents
- Official legal notice to appear mailed

ROE 1 Interventions Step 4

Status Check

- If student attendance does not improve, legal action may be taken
- If student attendance improves, ROE will continue to monitor
